

MagLab Liquid Helium Use Policy

Users of MagLab facilities who require low temperatures to carry out their high magnetic field research and who use one of the MagLab standard cryostat/dewar combinations will not be charged for liquid helium (LHe) as these systems have been designed to recover the helium boil-off gas. Users performing experiments for which the helium boil-off gas cannot be recovered (e.g. high critical current measurements of superconductors) are not charged for the first LHe cryostat, but will be charged for any additional LHe used in the experiment.
